



EXPLORE THE PARK

Four Paws Dog Park members may visit the park at any time from dawn to dusk 7 days a week

Dogs must be members to enter the Park

Memberships and passes can only be obtained during SAVC business hours located to the left.

The Four Paws Dog Park is for dogs and their owners/handlers only. No animals other than dogs shall be permitted in the Park. The Park is divided into **two enclosed areas**. One area is designed for active/herding/large dogs. A second area is designed for small/older/shy dogs. On each visit you may use either enclosure. Please use good judgment when other patrons are using the park. The Park's **safety features** include **electronic entry**, **5-foot fencing**, and a **double-gated entry/exit**. We will provide benches for you and drinking water for your dog. South Anderson Veterinary Clinic **does not supervise visitors** at the Four Paws Dog Park, and therefore Park patrons are individually responsible for guarding against the risks posed by unleashed dogs. If you are interested in becoming a Four Paws Dog Park member, please (1) complete our membership application and liability waiver, (2) review our rules and etiquette, and (3) bring a copy of your dog's current health and vaccination records on your initial visit to South Anderson Veterinary Clinic. This is important so we can verify you dog's vaccination and parasite status before your dog can be admitted into the park.

MEMBERSHIP

Memberships are available in three forms including a trial day pass, a monthly pass, and an annual membership. Pricing is available on our Membership Application. There are savings for multiple household pets. Passes can be purchased with cash or any major credit card.

- Trial day passes can be redeemed only during SAVC regular business hours.
- Monthly passes are valid for 30 days from the date of purchase
- Annual passes are valid for 365 days from the date of purchase
- SAVC clients will receive a 20% savings on the first household dog's annual pass.
- There is a \$10 fee for the monthly and annual key cards (one per household). Lost/broken/damaged cards may be replaced for \$10.

- Passes are nonrefundable and may be revoked for infraction of the park rules.
- Once registered, a membership dog tag and key card are issued at the SAVC office for monthly and annual members.
- Once the pass purchased expires, the key card will deactivate and no longer work.
- Please keep the key card away from any barcode scanners. This may cause your card to deactivate and require the purchase of a replacement.



WHAT DOES MY DOG NEED?

The Four Paws Dog Park values safety for your pet. This means all dogs must have annual vaccinations approved by SAVC prior to entering the dog park. Please bring a current copy with you when registering your dog(s). We require Rabies, Distemper, Parvovirus, and Bordetella vaccinations. Leptospirosis vaccine is strongly recommended, but not required. Dogs are required to be parasite-free and must provide proof of a negative fecal exam when registering and entering the Four Paws Dog Park. If your dog has not had a negative fecal exam in the past year, please bring a stool sample with you when you register your pet and allow one business day for the results before your dog is eligible to enter the park. Year-round flea and heartworm preventative is also strongly recommended. Puppies under four months of age cannot be registered and should not enter the Park. Puppies under four months of age have not received all of their vaccinations and should not enter the Park for their own protection. All male dogs must be neutered and female dogs must not be in heat.

PARK ETIQUETTE

Each member should enter using his/her own key card. Please do not permit members to enter the Park unless they have also swiped their card. You must not grant entry to unauthorized users or unregistered dogs or privileges will be revoked. All dogs must have current Rabies tag, ID tag, and Four Paws Dog Park tag on their collar at all times. SAVC staff will do random walk-through's to check for Four Paws Dog Park tags and unauthorized users.

- One person/handler is required to be present for every 2 dogs.
- Dogs must be leashed upon entering and exiting the park with a collar on at all times.
- Prong collars are not permitted because other dogs can get injured while playing.
- Dogs must be supervised at all times and under voice control by the owner/handler. If you must leave the park, your dog(s) must go with you.
- Children under 12 are not permitted in the Park for their own safety.
- A person may not conduct dog training classes in the Park other than South Anderson Obedience School.
- We reserve the right to close the Park at any time for mowing or routine maintenance.

- Owners/handlers are required to pick up after themselves and their animals. Clean-up stations are provided for your convenience.
- Dogs are not allowed to dig in the Park.
 Owners/handlers must immediately fill in any holes made by their pet(s).
- Do not bring food dishes, favorite toys, or food. Small training treats are allowed.
- Members can bring a tennis ball or Frisbee as long as it does not provoke other dogs or cause guarding behavior.
- Owners/handlers are expected to comply with all applicable ordinances, regulations, and laws governing dogs.
- Aggressive dogs are not permitted in the park.
